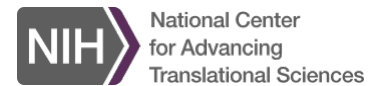

### TRIDENT COVID-19 PROJECT INVITATION

**Duke Clinical Research Institute** invites you to help to facilitate a study called TRIDENT COVID-19. This study is a follow-up registry study of infants who tested positive for the COVID-19 virus or whose mothers tested positive for COVID-19 virus. The study involves completion of questionnaires when the infant is 6 and 12 months of age and review of infant and maternal medical records.

### WHY IS THIS STUDY IMPORTANT?

This study will help us to better understand the medical and social outcomes of mothers and children that have been exposed and/or diagnosed with the COVID-19 virus. We do not know the long-term impact of this new infection on women or their newborn infants. Important information from this study will inform how we can improve therapies for pregnant women and their children.

### WHAT WILL I BE ASKED TO DO?

During the birth hospitalization, identify newborns and mothers who have tested positive for COVID-19. Give mothers hand-outs and encourage them to participate in the study.

### WHICH PATIENTS ARE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE?

#### Inclusion criteria:

- Infants discharged from hospital managed by the Pediatrix Medical Group
- Infants:
  - a. Positive for COVID-19 virus by discharge
  - b. born to mothers positive for SARS-CoV-2 during primary hospitalization or at discharge

#### Exclusion criteria:

- Mother-infant pairs in which the infant dies during the hospitalization

### WHAT WILL MY PATIENTS BE ASKED TO DO?

- Duration of the study: 12 months
- Enroll in study using the link in the hand-out
- Provide consent for access of medical records
- Complete follow-up questionnaires at 6 and 12 months
